ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Intellectual property refers to mind creation: inventions, works of literature and art, and symbols, names, and images used in commerce. Intellectual property rights have been widely recognized as a catalyst for development in global economies as a whole. Intellectual property rights regime can impact the cycle of growth through an economy's domestic and external sector. Intellectual property rights can promote economic growth in recipient countries through different channels. The most important is the transition of technology and its positive spillovers. Therefore, Intellectual property rights exert economic growth, which requires productivity growth; productivity growth requires technological innovation to increase and it requires efficient protection of Intellectual Property Rights.

As the knowledge economy progresses, more and more value is attained by firms & the overall economy will come from intangibles of high value including Intellectual Property in inventions, brands & works. Now 80 percent or more of its market value is attributable to intangibles in many companies, including Intellectual Property. Hence, it is evident that Intellectual property rights could play a significant role in encouraging innovation, product development, and technical change. The incentives to innovate, intellectual property rights protection impacts economic growth in important ways. The evidence suggests that intellectual property protection is a significant determinant of economic growth. These effects appear to be slightly stronger in relatively open economies and are robust to both the measure of openness used and to other alternative model specification.
