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## **1. About the University**

The ICFAI University, Dehradun, Uttarakhand (hereinafter referred to as the University) was established under the ICFAI University Act 2003 (Act No.16 of 2003) passed by the Uttaranchal Legislative Assembly and assented to by the Governor on July 08, 2003.

The ICFAI University secured **44<sup>th</sup> rank in the World Universities with Real Impact (WURI) Rankings 2020** released by United Nations Institute for Training and Research. ICFAI is the only non- governmental institution among two Indian Universities in this list. The University has also been awarded with the certificate for **E- Learning Excellence of Academic Digitisation (e-LEAD)**.

## **2. About ICFAI Law School, Dehradun**

ICFAI Law School (formerly known as Faculty of Law), a constituent of the ICFAI University, Dehradun is established with the objective of developing a new generation of legal professionals through the comprehensive body of knowledge integrating law with Management/Humanities.

The Bar Council of India has accorded its approval for imparting three year and five year Law Courses at ICFAI University, Dehradun, Uttarakhand and award degrees in law.

The ICFAI Law School, Dehradun is the **6<sup>th</sup> Ranking Law School of Super Excellence and 1<sup>st</sup> Ranking Law School in Uttarakhand according to CSR GHRDC Law School Rankings 2020**. ### **3. About the Center for Cyber Law and Innovation**

It focuses on providing legal services and consultancy in the area of Internet-based transaction. ### **4. About the Conference**

The Virtual Conference on Cybersecurity in 4<sup>th</sup> Industrial Revolution aims to analyze the emerging Cyber law and Cyber security trends, concepts and challenges in the era of Internet of Things or Industrial Revolution 4.0. It would provide an intellectual platform for multidisciplinary discussions on critical issues concerning cyberspace.

## **5. Rules and Regulations**

- The Conference is open for students, academicians, and professionals.
- Co-authorship to a maximum of two authors is permitted.
- Only one submission shall be allowed per author, and in case of co-authors, one submission shall be deemed to include both. Separate submissions of co-authors shall be taken as multiple submissions, which will be subject to rejection and disqualification.
- The link for the sessions of the conference shall be mailed to the participants one day before the conference.

## **7. Registration and Abstract Submission**

- a. **Registration for the Conference shall be free of cost.**
- b. A brief abstract not exceeding 300 words, on the topic chosen, must be emailed to the organizers at [prachi.mishra@iudehradun.edu.in](mailto:prachi.mishra@iudehradun.edu.in) in Word format on or before **15<sup>th</sup> October, 2020**.
- c. A five-digit Unique code shall be mailed to the participants whose abstract would be shortlisted.
- d. The participants whose abstracts are shortlisted are directed not to mention any of their personal details while submitting their Paper. Furnishing any such detail shall lead to disqualification.

## **8. Paper Submissions**

- a. The soft copy of Paper(one in Word file and one in Pdf) must be emailed to the organizers at [prachi.mishra@iudehradun.edu.in](mailto:prachi.mishra@iudehradun.edu.in) latest by **30<sup>th</sup> October, 2020**.
- b. The subject of the e-mail and name of the file must be “Paper Submission XXXXX(Unique no.)”.

## **9. Guidelines**

- a. The Paper shall be in English.
- b. The name(s) of the author(s) must not be disclosed or mentioned anywhere in the Paper.
- c. The word limit for the Paper is 2000-4000words, which is exclusive of footnotes or any other references.
- d. The mandatory formatting specifications for the Paper are
  - i. 1-inch margin on all sides;
  - ii. Times New Roman with 12 font size & 1.5-line spacing.

- iii. For footnotes, the mandatory formatting specifications shall be Times New Roman typeface with 10font size; and Single (1) line spacing.
- e. References and precedents must be cited throughout the Article using the Bluebook 20<sup>th</sup> edition citation Method.
- f. The paper should be the original work of the authors & must not have been published elsewhere.
- g. The submissions must be in both Word (.doc/.docx) and PDF (.pdf) formats.
- h. Authors must strictly follow the guidelines failing which their submission may not be considered.

### **10. Evaluation of Papers**

- a. Every Paper shall be evaluated on a scale of 100 marks.
- b. The criteria for evaluating an Article shall be:
  - i. Clarity of Thought – 10 marks
  - ii. Grammar and Language -10marks
  - iii. Presentation- 30 marks
  - iv. Proper and Articulate Analysis -25 marks
  - v. Novelty -25 marks

### **11. Awards**

- **Certificate of Achievement shall be awarded to the following**
  - Best Paper Presentation
  - Best Paper
  - Best in session Paper Presentation
  - Best in session Paper.
- Certificate of Participation to all the participants presenting the paper.

## **12. Miscellaneous**

- a. No paper or any part thereof, should have been published or should be under consideration for publication or a contest otherwise than this conference. Furthermore, any form of plagiarism will result in disqualification of the paper. Plagiarism higher than 15% shall be disqualified in the preliminary round of evaluation.
- b. The authors by virtue of submitting the paper, give the University, the right to publish the entries without any royalty or compensation.
- c. A Panel of Evaluators shall be constituted to evaluate and select the winning entries and the decision of the Panel shall be final and binding.
- d. The participant by entering in the conference agrees to indemnify the University from and against claims, suit and damages based on any claim of copyright infringement or plagiarism or unauthorized use.
- e. The University reserves the absolute rights to cancel, defer or postpone indefinitely, the conference in an event accruing to any contingency, natural or man-made.

**In case of any dispute, the decision of the University shall be final and binding and is not liable to any clarification to any of the participants regarding evaluation of his/her paper.**
