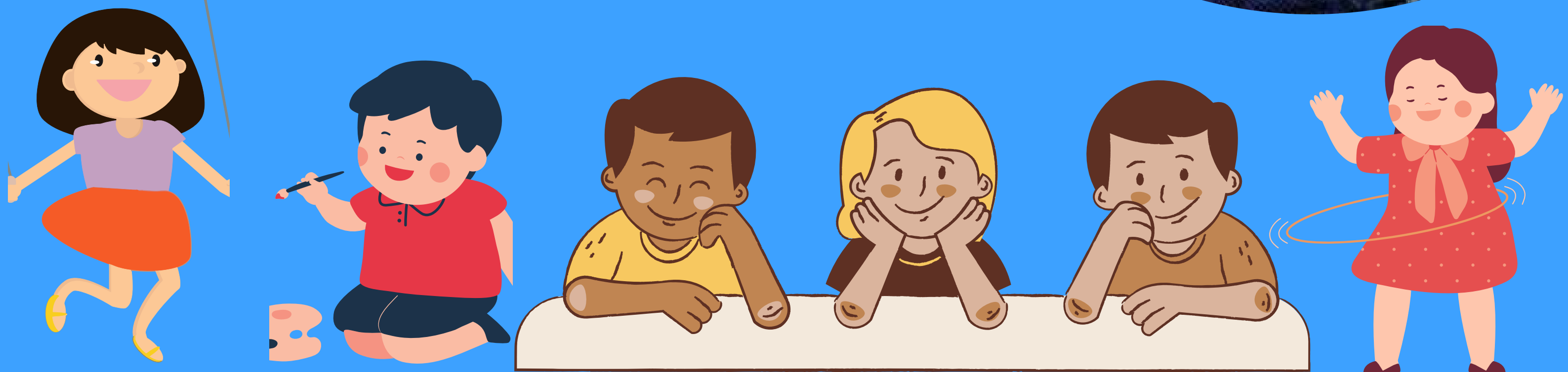

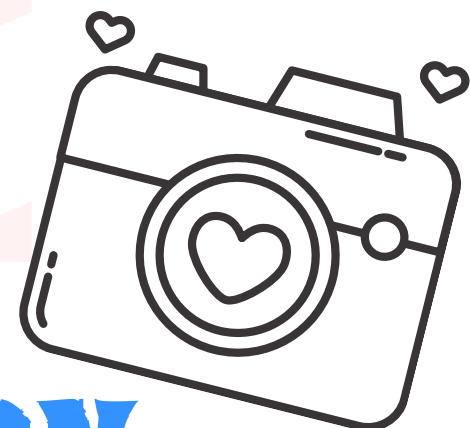
About CNLU, Patna

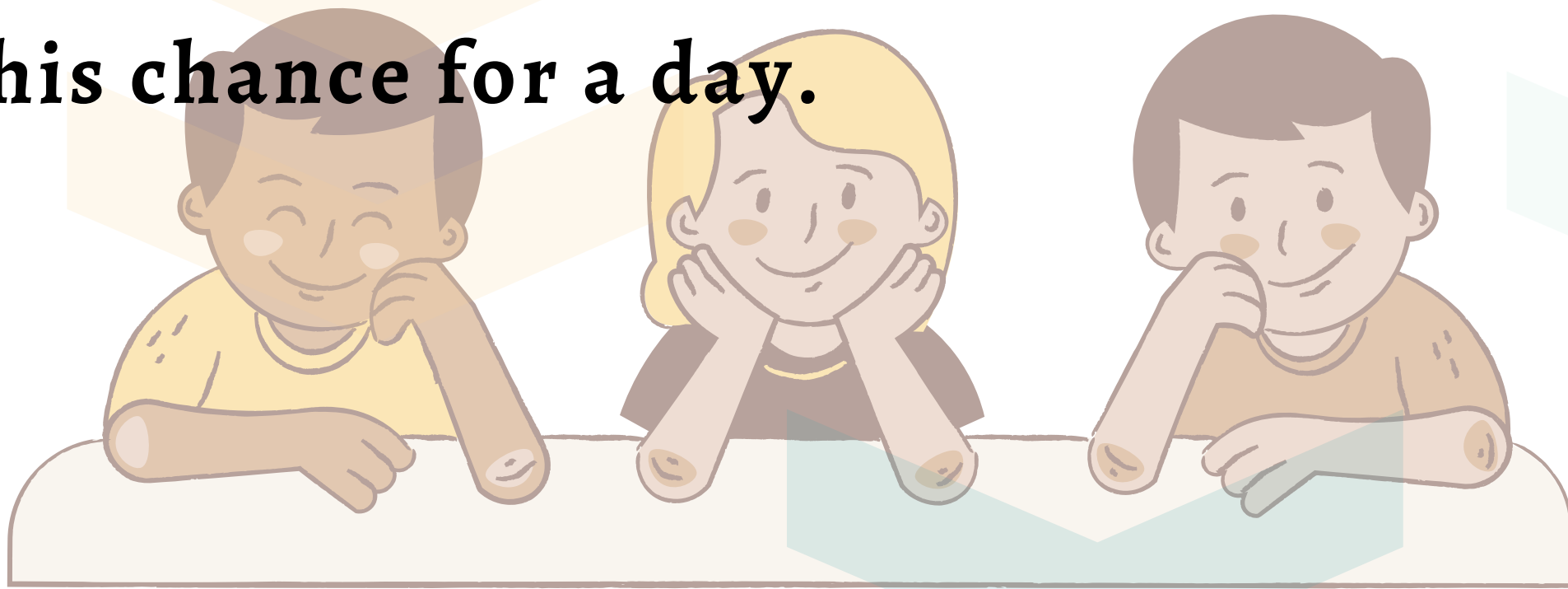
