Submission Guidelines

- The submissions must be in English language.
- The file must be in .doc/.docx format
- All entries must be mailed at:nssggsipu2020@gmail.com
- The article must include the topic whereas there should be no mention of the author's name and institution in the body of the article.
- The word limit is min. 1500 words and max. 2500 (exclusive of footnotes)
- Co-authorship upto maximum of two authors is allowed. (authors can be from different institutions)
- Any uniform style of citations must be followed, for example: OSCOLA, Bluebook 20th edn., ILI etc.
- Plagiarism upto 20% is acceptable. (Based on Turnitin similarity index)
- The file name of the submission must be as follows: 'Full name of author.doc/.docx' (in case of single author) and 'Author1 First name_Author2 First name.doc/.docx' (in case of more than one authors).



Formatting Guidelines

- The article must be typed in Times New Roman, Font size- 12(body) and 14 (headings), line spacing: 1.5, alignment type: justified.
- The footnotes must be typed in Times New Roman, Font size- 10, Line spacing- 1.0

- Any form of references, whether online or offline must be duly cited with proper credits. Any uniform citation style can be used, for example: OSCOLA, Bluebook, ILI etc.

Judging Criteria

- Clarity of Idea and Expression.
- Uniqueness of content.
- Pragmatic solutions to issues of contemporary relevance.
- Depth and quality of research.

Important Note

- The submission must be original and unpublished work of the author.
- Rules/Guidelines are subject to change as per university norms.
- The copyright of the published articles shall rest with the organising Institution: USLLS, GGSIPU.
- Plagiarized content shall not be entertained and shall be subjected to disqualification
- Non-compliance with either of the guidelines mentioned above will result in immediate rejection of submission. No queries in this regard shall be entertained.

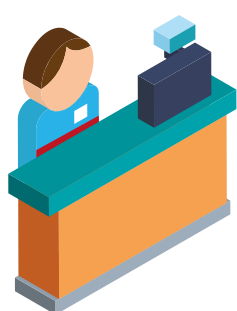
Important Dates
